


- ❑ How should this be applied in the church? How does 1 Corinthians 12.27 and 1 Corinthians 5.12-13 help us understand this clearly.

### ARK 9 CHANGING DIRECTIONS

Jesus ministry in Galilee is rapidly drawing to a close. He is now about to start the journey toward Jerusalem that will lead to his sacrificial death for the sins of all of humanity. Even as he starts this change of direction he has to remind the disciples of his ultimate personal **mission**. Even during this trying time he makes time to **minister** to the needs of a boy.

**Read verse 1**(TITLE) \_\_\_\_\_

- ❑ When was the Kingdom of God promised to be made evident?
  
- ❑ Why is this important for believers today?

**Read verses 2-4 (TITLE) \_\_\_\_\_**

- ❑ Who is seen with Jesus and what do they represent from the Old Testament?

- ❑ What does it mean when it says Jesus was transfigured?

- ❑ How does this help or remind us of who Jesus really is?

**Read verses 5-8 (TITLE) \_\_\_\_\_**

- ❑ What does Peter do here that he should have not done? (see Psalm 46.10)

- ❑ What is wrong with what Peter is suggesting?

- ❑ Vs. 37 What do we learn about God here that we need to remember everyday?

**Read verses 38-41 (TITLE) \_\_\_\_\_**

- ❑ How should we apply this to our lives as believers?

- ❑ How can this be misapplied and cause harm?

**verses 42-50 (TITLE) \_\_\_\_\_**

- ❑ Vs. 42 Does this make us responsible for the sins of others?

- ❑ Vss. 43-48 How should this be applied to the lives of individual believers?

- ❑ Vss. 26-29 What is the key to our understanding healing as Jesus taught it here?

**Read verses 30-32 (TITLE) \_\_\_\_\_**

- ❑ Why did Jesus keep telling the disciples something they did not understand?

**Read verses 33-37 (TITLE) \_\_\_\_\_**

- ❑ Why do you think the disciples were having this disagreement?

- ❑ Vs. 35 How is this different than everything in the physical world?

- ❑ How should the believer apply this to their personal lives?

- ❑ How is Peter corrected?

- ❑ How is this different that when Jesus corrected Peter in Mark 8.33 where Jesus told Peter to get behind him?

- ❑ What is significant about the disappearance of the other two leaving only Jesus?

**Read verses 9-13 (TITLE) \_\_\_\_\_**

- ❑ Vss. 9-10 Why would the disciples be confused about their understanding about Jesus saying he will rise from the dead?

- ❑ Vs. 11 (see Malachi 4.5) Why is this important for us to see and understand even in our time?

- ❑ Matthew 11.11-14 Who does Jesus say is the Elijah who was to come before him?
  
- ❑ Vs. 12-13 According to Jesus why is the prophet Elijah important to knowing who He is?
  
- ❑ Why did the son of man have to suffer and be rejected?

**Read verses 14-32**(TITLE) \_\_\_\_\_

- ❑ Vss. 14-18 What problem(s) did Jesus find when he came off the mountain?
  
- ❑ How is this like your personal experiences when you have an uplifting time that is followed by a problem?

- ❑ Vs. 19 Why was Jesus frustrated with the people?
  
- ❑ How does this show his human side; his divine side?
  
- ❑ Vss. 20-22 How do the people relate to Jesus here?
  
- ❑ How does this show their faith or lack of faith?
  
- ❑ Vss. 23-24 What do we learn about faith here and how it works in the lives of others?
  
- ❑ Vs. 25. How does Jesus deal with the demon?
