

Answer the following questions. (NOTE: The word translated antichrists and antichrist is exactly the same word)

- ◆ What is an antichrist?

Read 1 John 2.18:

- ◆ How did John view the time he lived in?

- ◆ What did John mean by the last hour?

- ◆ What did he expect to happen in the last hour.

- ◆ According to John how many antichrist are there?

- ◆ Read 1 John 2.19 How does John describe those who are called antichrist?

- ◆ Read 1 John 2.22 How do you know if someone is an antichrist.

- ◆ Read 1 John 4.1-3 According to John how does someone become an antichrist?

- ◆ Define what an antichrist is.
- ◆ How is this different from how most people view the world antichrist?
- ◆ How do we as believers know what an antichrist really is?

- ◆ Read Matthew 24.14 What do you think this scripture is making reference to?
- ◆ Read Colossians 1.23 Where had the gospel been proclaimed or preached when Paul wrote this letter around 60-62 A.D.

- ◆ Read Romans 1.8 When Paul wrote to the church in Rome around 57-59 A.D. how far had the message of Jesus spread?
- ◆ Acts 17.6 When was this written? What does this tell us about the extent of the spread of Christianity and the preaching about the good news of Jesus?
- ◆ Since most of the world as we know it today had not been discovered yet how can you explain what Paul means by these statements.
- ◆ Read Acts 2.5 Who is represented in Jerusalem on the day of Pentecost and the birth of the Church at the preaching of Peters message?
- ◆ How does this help explain the spread of the Gospel to the entire world as they knew it in the first century?
- ◆ Is the preaching of the Gospel a sign holding Jesus back from returning and bringing time to an end?
