4. Faith is _____ about _____

By faith he made his home in the promised land like a stranger in a foreign country; he lived in tents, as did Isaac and Jacob, who were heirs with him of the same promise. For he was looking forward to the city with foundations, whose architect and builder is God. Hebrews 11.9-10

5. Faith is _____ about _____

By faith Abraham, even though he was past age—and Sarah herself was barren—was enabled to become a father because he considered him faithful who had made the promise. And so from this one man, and he as good as dead, came descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and as countless as the sand on the seashore. Hebrews 11.11-12

6. Faith is _____ about _____

By faith Abraham, when God tested him, offered Isaac as a sacrifice. He who had received the promises was about to sacrifice his one and only son, even though God had said to him, "It is through Isaac that your offspring will be reckoned." Abraham reasoned that God could raise the dead, and figuratively speaking, he did receive Isaac back from death. Hebrews 11.17-19

5. _____ : By faith Moses... chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a short time. Hebrews 11. 24-25
6. _____ : By faith Moses' parents hid him for three months after he was born... Heb. 11.23
7. _____ : without faith it is impossible to please God, Heb. 11.6
