It is inevelable that rightens men die Here Isrich says that no one notices. IT IS AS IF THEY JUST DISAPPEAR Great men of God pass and there is hardly a mention of them or their lives. When the righteos die they are moving from "calemity" of this world to the poace of Heaven . This is seen as moving from a work of turmoil to a place of rest. The implication is that as each rightens believer dies no one notices and no one tester their place. He passes over to peace ? leaves the claminy behind (3) Here are those with Remain wHEN THE RIGHTEOUS ARE REMOVED. They are involved in both religious and physical sins. Here Goo cells them to come before Him as He prepares to ask them Questions. (4) He wants to know if they have any idea who it is they are moderny with their lives, worship and religious beliefs? He then controlls them as products of other sinners. THEIR VERY Existance is based on breaking Goo's Laws. (5) This is a reference to Consenite worship among the Oaks. Use. 1.29; (1.3 (cf Deut 12.2; Jer. 2.20; 3.6; Ezek 6.13; IK 14.23) This included sexual interaction as part of the idol worstip. They sacrificed THEIR CHILDREN to Boal or to Molech THESZ practices were forbidden by Gop. (Lev. 18.21; Deut. 12.31; Mic. 6.7, etc) (6) THZ opening line may refer to some worship practice bud it is not clear what is being referenced here. - 58 "Cry aloud; do not hold back; lift up your voice like a trumpet; declare to my people their transgression, to the house of Jacob their sins.
 - Yet they seek me daily and delight to know my ways, as if they were a nation that did righteousness and did not forsake the judgment of their God; they ask of me righteous judgments; they delight to draw near to God.
- 'Why have we fasted, and you see it not? Why have we humbled ourselves, and you take no knowledge of it?'

Behold, in the day of your fast you seek your own pleasure,

and oppress all your workers.

- Behold, you fast only to quarrel and to fight and to hit with a wicked fist.
 - Fasting like yours this day will not make your voice to be heard on high.

- 19 Gon declares the offer is available to everyone no matter where they are (for or near). His hooling is both spiritual and physical. Here is a promise to those who respond to his leading,
- (20-21) Here the section is concluded wa warning THE promises of God are not intended for the wicked They will live lives of turmoil, tossed about wort a foundation. Even as the righteous are blessed w/ Eap's peace the wided Live in Fear always under a Hack
- 1) Goo tells Issish to declare in a loud voice their sins and transgressing Here He calls them local the deciever. The prophet is not to hold back 95 he preaches the message he has received from Goo.
- (2) Here we see usly God is so upset us Hem. They want the benefits of Knowing God but do not live as the people of Goo Here their worstip is for selfish reasons They are acting, believing God dow not see anything beyond what they want Him to see. Here empty worship is offered hoping to gain insight & Favor wort service or righteousness.
- (3) THE people want to know why they fast if Gon will not auswer them. Goo responds that their fasting is mixed w/ their seeking pleasure. The people think their acts and actions are enough to please Goo. Goo responds that He see every thing they do, not just the fasting that they hope impresses Goo.
- 1) They are merely doing a religious exercise to somehow earn Goo's favor, but their lives are unchanged. THEIR evil I festyle is in no way changed by their "self-righteous" worship. Gon is clear that such a lifestyle stops Goo from even heaving them. THER Hypochicy stops Goo's mercy and grace from being Given to them. Goo is not opposed to fasting. It is just theirs is not real fasting and will in no way impact GoD.
- (50) When Goo looks to earth the fast He expeds is very different than what they are doing. Such a fast starts we humble and contribe heart. It is a time of submission and a return to worship to seek Goo's will. It is a time to seek Goo, not a time to demand or even expect anything beyond the Holy presence of Goo examing your life!
