



### Lesson in PRAYER from Hezekiah #2

- The threat of evil.
- 37.14 Hezekiah received the letter from the hand of the messengers, and read it; and Hezekiah went up to the house of the LORD, and spread it before the LORD.
- His prayer contained:
  - to the "LORD of host." Vs. 16
    to be heard Vs. 17 (incline your ear)
    they are facing Vss. 17-19 (see and hear)
    of the request Vs. 20 (save us from his hand)
- 37.21 "Thus says the LORD, the God of Israel: Because you have PRAYED to me concerning Sennacherib king of Assyria..."

### Lesson in PRAYER from Hezekiah #3

- Vs. 1 Hezekiah is sick and near death when Isaiah tells the king this sickness will end in death.
- Vss. 2-3 Then Hezekiah turned his face to the wall and to the LORD, and said, "Please, O LORD, remember how I have walked before you in faithfulness and with a whole heart, and have done what is good in your sight." And Hezekiah wept bitterly.
