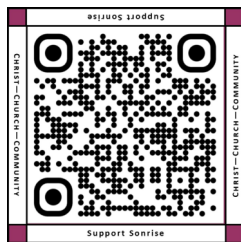

- ◆ This is usually expressed using the alphabet. An example would be a b c c b a or a b c d X d c b a.
- ◆ In Isaiah 53 vss. 7 & 8a we have a Chiasm.

Chiasms help us focus on important truths.

MONDAY: Read Genesis 3.5-22. This Chiasm has six steps.

TUESDAY: Read Genesis Ephesians 1.12-19 There are 8 steps in this one with a middle X or central message.

WEDNESDAY: Read 1 Peter 1.23-25. There are 4 steps, but I must warn you one of them is out of order.

THURSDAY: Read Genesis 6.9-9.29. There are 5 steps, and there is a middle X that is super important.

FRIDAY: Read Colossians 1.13-20c. There are four steps with a central X.

SATURDAY: Read Ephesians 3.14-21. There are five steps with a central X.

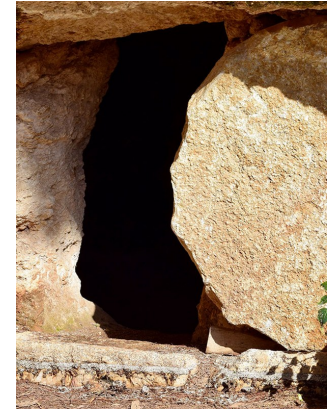
