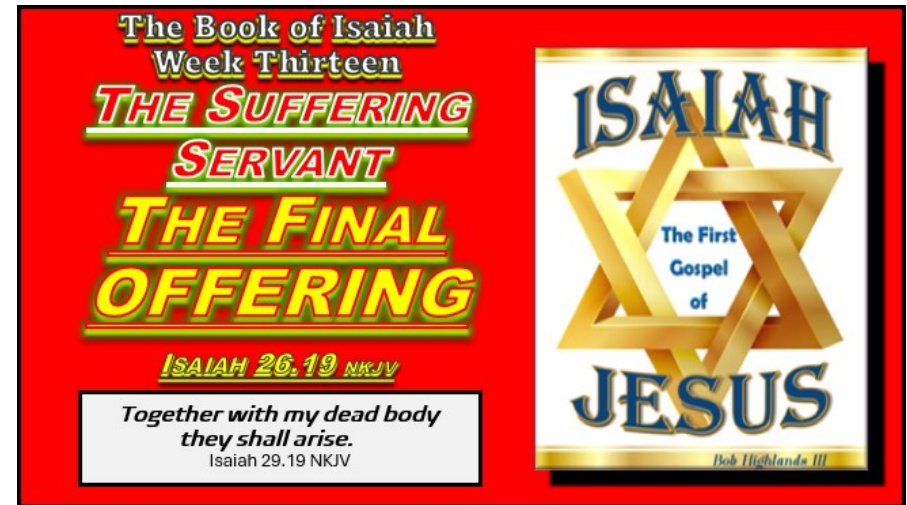

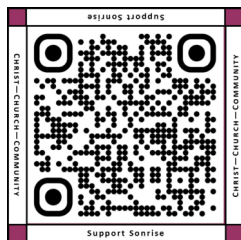

Your dead shall live; **Together with MY dead body** they shall arise. Awake and sing, you who dwell in dust; For your dew is like the dew of herbs, And the earth shall cast out the dead. NKJV

Thy dead shall live, with MY corpse shall they rise. Awake and shout, ye dwelling in dust: for the dew of brightness is thy dew, and the land of the shades shall fall.

Leviticus 7.1-5

- ♦ Leviticus 7.1-5 details the _____ or TRESPASS offering and how it would be carried out. This is the guilt offering of the Suffering Servant from Isaiah 53.10.
- ♦ Vss. 1-2 This is a _____ offering that is killed (sacrificed), and the _____ is thrown on the sides of the altar.
- ♦ Vss. 3-4 The _____, the two _____, and the _____ were removed so they could be _____ on the altar.*
- ♦ Vs. 5 *"The priest shall _____ THEM on the altar as an offering to the LORD; it is a _____."*

1 Corinthians 3.13-15

- ♦ Jesus is the **GUILT OFFERING** for the sins of all who call on His name for Salvation.
- ♦ His blood on the cross is part of the requirement for this offering. This is the _____ for our sins.
- ♦ There is a second part of the GUILT OFFERING. This is the BURNING of the KIDNEYS and the LIVER.
- ♦ This is about purification or the _____ of sins.
- ♦ 1 Corinthians 3.13-15 *each man's work will become evident; for the day will show it because it is to be*



This week, we are looking at the Apostles' Creed

Each day look up the scripture text and answer the questions: Why is it important for me to know this? How does this help my faith in Christ?

MONDAY: I believe in God, the Father almighty, (Mt 5 :45)
Creator of heaven and earth, (Gen 1: 1; Rom 1: 20)
And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, (Mt 3: 17; Phil 2: 12)

TUESDAY: Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, (Lk 1: 35)
born of the Virgin Mary, (Lk 2: 7)
suffered under Pontius Pilate, (Jn 19: 16)
was crucified, died, and was buried. (Jn 19: 29 – 42)

WEDNESDAY: He descended into hell; (1 Pet 3: 19 – 20)
on the third day He rose again from the dead, (Mt 28:1-10; Jn 20:11-18)

He ascended in heaven, (Lk 24: 51)
and sits at the right hand of God, (Heb 1: 3)

THURSDAY: the Father almighty; (Mk 14: 36)
from thence He shall come again (Mt 16: 27; Acts 10: 39;)
to judge the living and the dead. (1 Cor 15: 51)

FRIDAY: I believe in the Holy Spirit, (Jn 14: 15 – 20; Acts 1: 7 – 8)
the Holy Catholic* Church, (Mt 16: 18 – 19; Eph 5: 26-27; Col 1: 24)
the communion of Saints, (Mt 28: 19 – 20; 2 Cor 11: 13; 1 Cor 15: 33)

SATURDAY: the forgiveness of sins, (Jn 20: 22 – 23)
the resurrection of the body, (1Cor 15: 51 – 54; 1 Thes 4: 13 – 18)
and life everlasting. (1 Jn 5: 20)

*Catholic means universal or one united church.

- ♦ “He himself bore our sins” in his _____ on the _____, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; “by his wounds you have been healed.”
- ♦ This is one-half of the Guilt offering. The sacrifice of His _____ for our sins. The sprinkling of blood on the altar.

The Offering of His SOUL

- ♦ The **GUILT OFFERING** was completed when Christ went through the fires of Hell to burn up our sins.
- ♦ *when his _____ makes an offering for guilt,* Isa. 53.10 This is beyond the physical. His SOUL carries our sins into the eternal fires of hell.
- ♦ *Out of the anguish of his _____ he shall see and be satisfied;* Isa. 53.11 This is the removal of our sins, which he bore for us.
- ♦ *because he poured out his _____ to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin of many,* Isa. 53.12 This is the time in hell between Jesus’ death and resurrection.

The Complete Guilt Offering

- ♦ The **Sprinkling** of Blood: Jesus on the _____
- ♦ *Your dead shall live; **Together with MY dead** _____ they shall arise. Awake and sing, you who dwell in dust; For your dew is like the dew of herbs, And the earth shall cast out the dead.* Isaiah 26.19 NKJV
- ♦ The **Sacrificial** Burning away of Sins: Jesus in _____
- ♦ *Yet it was the will of the LORD to crush him; he has put him to grief; **when HIS** _____ makes **a GUILT OFFERING**,* Isaiah 53.10

_____ **with fire**, and the fire itself will _____ the quality of each man's work. If any man's work which he has built on it remains, he will receive a reward. If **any man's work is** _____ **up**, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.

Isaiah 6.1-7

- ♦ Isaiah 6.1-4 Isaiah finds himself before God. The angels are flying around declaring the holiness of God. The place fills with smoke and the foundations shake.
- ♦ Vss. 5-7 And I said: “*Woe is me! For I am lost; for I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts!*”
*Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a _____ **that he had taken with tongs from the** _____. And he touched my mouth and said: “Behold, this has touched your lips; **your guilt is taken away**, and your sin _____ for.”*

- ♦ Malachi 3.2-3 NLT “*But who will be able to endure it when he comes? Who will be able to stand and face him when he appears? For he will be like a _____ that refines metal, or like a strong soap that bleaches clothes. He will sit like a refiner of silver, _____ the dross. **He will** _____ the Levites, refining them like gold and silver, so **that they may once again offer acceptable sacrifices** to the LORD.*”

1 Corinthians 5.21

- ♦ *For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the _____ for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ. 1 Corinthians 5.21*
- ♦ An offering had two key parts.
 1. The _____ of blood and
 2. The _____ of the sacrifice.



1 Peter 3.18-20

- ♦ The _____ OF THE BLOOD - Christ on the _____
- ♦ Christ _____ for our sins once for all time. He never sinned, but he died for sinners to bring you safely home to God. He suffered physical death, but he was raised to life in the Spirit.
- ♦ The _____ OF THE SACRIFICE – Christ in _____
- ♦ So he went and preached to the spirits IN _____ – *those who disobeyed God long ago when God waited patiently while Noah was building his boat. Only eight people were saved from drowning in that terrible flood.* 1 Peter 3.18-20
