This week, we will look at the CHURCH in Isaiah

Isaiah lays out the makeup and the promise of the coming church. Here are some key verses and questions for DIGGING DEEPER.

MONDAY: Isaiah 54.1-17 What key qualities does the church possess? What promises does God make about the church?

TUESDAY: Isaiah 55.1-13 What do we learn about salvation and its cost? What benefits of salvation are shown here? **WEDNESDAY**: Isaiah 56.1-8 Here the Kingdom (the church) is expanded. How is the Kingdom different than what already existed as the nation of Israel? Who is included in the New Kingdom of the saved?

THURSDAY: Isaiah 62.1-12 How is the church pictured here as part of a relationship? What promises does God make to the church because of this relationship?

FRIDAY: Isaiah 66.7-14 Here is Isaiah describing the birth of the church on the day of Pentecost. What facts do we learn about the birth of the church? (You can check Pastor Bob's notes online if you need additional help.)

SATURDAY: Isaiah 66.18-24 The two key themes of Isaiah are Hope and Judgment. How are each of these described here? Why do you think Isaiah finished the book the way he did in Isaiah 66.24?
