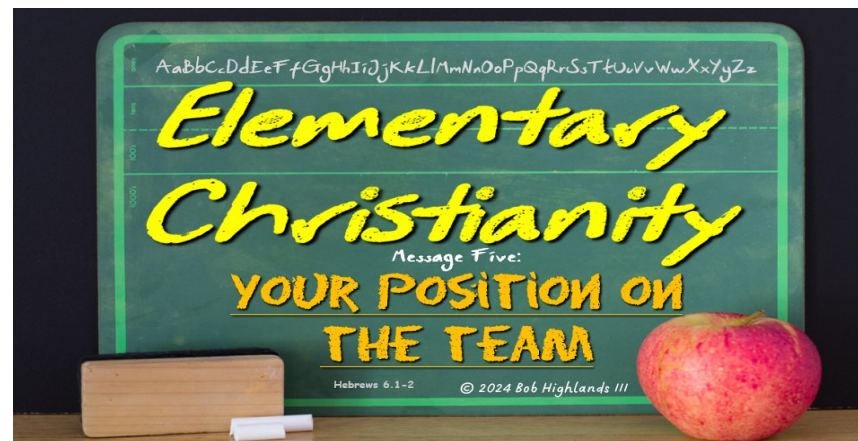

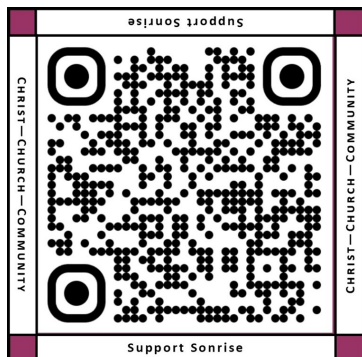

This week we are looking at the LAYING ON OF HANDS. This is all about ministry and mission. As you look at each of these examples consider how they are tied to the church and are for the benefit of the Kingdom of God.

Monday: Luke 18.15-15 How can this be used in the church today? What was Jesus' purpose in laying on hands here? How is this demonstrated in Genesis 48.8-16

Tuesday: Mark 16.18 Why would it be needed in some cases to lay hands on the sick for healing? How can this be better understood when also applying James 5.14-15 What do we learn about healing and the laying on of hands from Mark 6.5-6?

Wednesday: Acts 6.1-7 Why would these table waiters need to be prayed for with the laying on of hands? Consider why they were needed and what they were doing for the church.

Thursday: Acts 8.14-17 also Acts 2.38 Why would the new believers who were not acquainted with the Holy Spirit need to receive it as a separate gift while those who had a background with Jesus just received it as part of their salvation?

Friday: 1 Timothy 4.14 and Numbers 8.10 Why is it important for those already in ministry to ordain and lay hands on those who are just starting their ministry? Why should this never be done hastily?

BONUS: 2 Timothy 1.6 Gifts are not always given through the laying on of hands but when it happens how should the believer approach using the gift?

DOUBLE BONUS: Why would some churches and some cultures use the laying on of hands more than others?
