



THE TRANSITION

- This is moving from Life '_____" Eternal Life
- ◆ The '____' is all about death, and the dying of our body.
- This '_____' is what we will look at today.



Many individuals treat death with indifference, defiance, and even think of it as an end in itself. Yer, death is only a door. It is a transition point in our lives where we move from the physical to the spiritual. Death is the beginning and not the end.

Monday: 1 Corinthians 15.35-49 What do we learn about physical bodies? What do we learn about spiritual bodies? What do we learn about Christ Jesus or the 'last Adam' here?

<u>Tuesday</u>: 1 Corinthians 15.50-58 What do we learn about the transition from life to eternal life here? What changes and why when we die? What is the key for believers to always remember when facing troubles or temptations?

Wednesday: 1Kings 17.17-24 & 2 Kings 4.18-18-37 & Luke 7.11 -16 Here are three miracles of resurrection of the dead. One is by Elijah, one is by Elisha, and one by Jesus. Though rare in scripture (only 9 times) we can still learn from them. What do they have in common? What lesson can we learn by looking at these three side by side. In the end what happened to all three of the children who where raised back to life?

<u>Thursday</u>: <u>Hebrews 9.27-28</u> What do we learn about death and what comes next. (The next lesson will focus on this.) Why is Jesus coming back a second time?

<u>Friday</u>: Matthew 27.51-54 Here at the resurrection of Jesus we see the only time more than one person at a time returns from the dead. Why do you think this happened. What was the results of this happening? What happened to all these people who got a second opportunity at physical life?

<u>BONUS</u>: How should believers approach stories about people dying and coming back to life. How can they evaluate these stories to know if they are true or not?
