<u>SCRIPTURE LUKE 16.19-31</u>

"There was a rich man who was dressed in purple and fine linen and lived in luxury every day. At his gate was laid a beggar named Lazarus, covered with sores and longing to eat what fell from the rich man's table. Even the dogs came and licked his sores.

"The time came when the beggar died and the angels carried him to Abraham's side. The rich man also died and was buried. In hell, where he was in torment, he looked up and saw Abraham far away, with Lazarus by his side. So he called to him, 'Father Abraham, have pity on me and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my

tongue, because I am in agony in this fire.' "But Abraham replied, 'Son, remember that in your lifetime you received your good things, while Lazarus received bad things, but now he is comforted here and you are in agony.

And besides all this, between us and you a great chasm has been fixed, so that those who want to go from here to you cannot, nor can anyone cross over from there to us.' "He answered, 'Then I beg you, father, send Lazarus to my father's house, for I have five brothers. Let him warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.' "Abraham replied, 'They have Moses and the Prophets; let them listen to them.'

"'No, father Abraham,' he said, 'but if someone from the dead goes to them, they will repent.'

"He said to him, 'If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead." Luke 16.19-31



There is coming a day when you and I will come before God and all accounts will be settled. For those who know Jesus as their personal savior it means eternal life. For those who do not know Jesus the end will be very different and sad. Jesus was clear in Matthew 25.46 that this separation is coming. Are you ready to come before Him? If not, why not? If yes, PTL!

<u>Monday</u>: <u>2 Timothy 4.1-5</u> Who will judge the living and the dead? What actions does God expect from the followers of Jesus as they live their lives surrounded by non-believers?

<u>Tuesday</u>: John 3.16-21 What is the key to all people's judgment when they come before God. How can you tell is someone is following Jesus or are part of the world?

Wednesday: Matthew 13.24-30 & Matthew 13.36-43 Here is a parable about the end of time. Make a list of the items Jesus uses to illustrate His point. Then put down what Jesus says each one represents. Who is taken first at the end of time? Who is taken last? What happens to each one? (remember that judgment is eternal life or eternal punishment as shown by JESUS in verse 46). Remember Jesus is BOSS!

<u>Thursday</u>: <u>1 Thessalonians 4.14-18</u> Who are those who will come with Jesus at judgment to gather the living believers? What events will accompany His final return for eternal judgment? Why should this be seen as comfort for the believer? <u>Friday</u>: <u>Matthew 25.1-13</u> From this parable of Jesus what do we learn about the end of time and believers being prepared?

BONUS: <u>Matthew 25.31-46</u> What do we learn about the final judgment here? Jesus was plain in John 3.3 about being born from above. Beyond that what else does He expect of His followers. <u>SEE ALSO</u> Acts 10.42-43 Who is this about?


