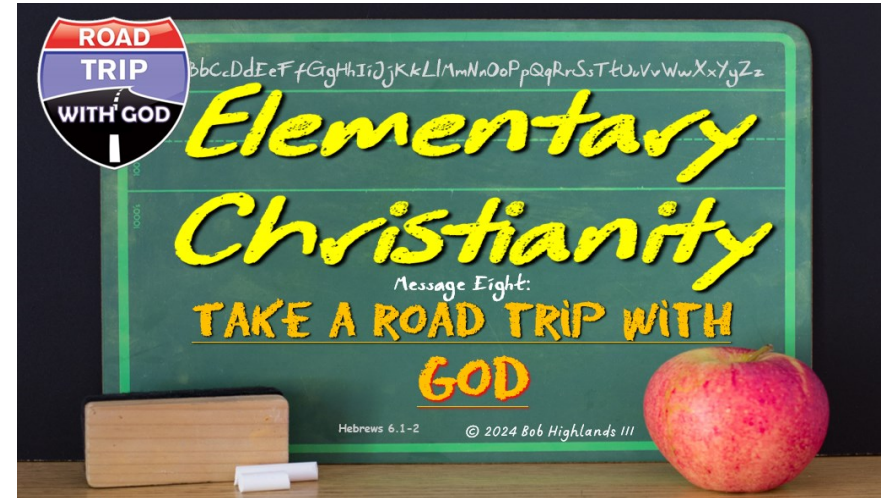

This week our extended lesson is about Christian conduct. We will use one verse for the week with a series of questions. Paul speaks about our calling and conduct. This week we will look at what Paul says in Ephesians about this new life. He clearly contrast it with the old way of life and speaks about our walk and calling as believers and followers of Christ Jesus.

Monday: Ephesians 4.1-7 What gives Paul the authority to direct how believers should live? What conduct should each believer demonstrate? What is the key to believers success?

Tuesday: Ephesians 4.8-16 How should Christ Jesus be viewed in relationship to humans? What types of leadership did Christ set up in the Church? Why are these needed? What is the ultimate goal of their leadership?

Wednesday: Ephesians 4.17-24 What attitudes and actions must be removed from the life of a believer? Who is Paul calling on to make these changes in the life of the believer? Why would Paul expect each believer to make these changes?

Thursday: Ephesians 4.25-32 What changes should happen in the life of the believer? How will these changes be evident? How will these changes effect the local church?

Friday: Ephesians 5.1-14 What is the key to living a successful Christian (Christ like) life? What separates the believer from the non-believer? How can you ultimately tell is someone is truly following Christ Jesus or just giving lip service?

BONUS: Ephesians 5.15-21 How should the believer view the world around him or her? What is a key to living a successful Christ like life? What instructions does he give to the believers? How can you apply these to your personal life?
