



These five core connections will help you grow and mature as a believer. This week our focus is on SUPPLICATION or PRAYER. Each day's exercise is designed to challenge you to dig deeper in your prayer life and discover it can expand and enrich you and your relationship with God and those around you.

Monday: Today your challenge is to do an ACTS prayer time. After reading your scriptures for today you are to write the word acts down the side of a page and then fill it out before praying. Then take time to show adoration to the father. Confess your sins and short coming for the previous day. Dig deep in being thankful for all God has done, and then spend time in supplication sharing your personal request with God.

<u>Tuesday</u>: Look at your notes for the Lord's prayer on page 3 of this study guide. Take a sheet of paper and list the numbers 1 thru 8 on the side. Then write out your prayer using the Lord's prayer as your guide with each part filled in. Then close your eyes and pray.

<u>Wednesday</u>: If you have not tried it yet today is SNAP-shot journal day. Follow the directions from the message with a piece of paper or notebook. Take time to let the scripture soak in and have meaning. Follow the steps: SCRIPTURE, NOTES, APPLICATION, and PRAYER. Consider using the SNAP-shot as you start you journey to have a personal devotional time every day.

<u>Thursday</u>: Choose a prayer from the Old Testament and use it with your SNAP-shot journal and prayer time.

<u>Friday</u>: Choose a prayer from the New Testament and use it with your SNAP-shot journal and prayer time.

<u>BONUS</u>: Rewrite the Lord's prayer in your own words and then use it with your SANP-shot journal and prayer time.
