

The Fellowship of Believers

The Believers Form a Community
All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles'

The Greek word for fellowship is *Koinonia*. It means a sharing that benefits both parties. It is about sharing the load or burden.

And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved.
