


#### Stewardship of Trust

<u>Monday</u>: TRUTH: Isaiah 65.16 What key qualities do we learn about God? How does this benefit the believer? How does Genesis 1.27 help us understand how this ties us to God?

<u>**Tuesday</u>**: TIME: Isaiah 57.15 & 2 Peter 3.8 How is God's perspective of time different than ours? Why is Christian time management a vital part of our lives as believers?</u>

**Wednesday**: TALENTS: Romans 12:6-8, 1 Corinthians 12:8-10; 28-30, and Ephesians 4:11. List the spiritual gifts from each section of scripture

<u>Thursday</u>: TITHES: Principles of giving: what do we learn in each section about Christian giving? (1) Proverbs 3.9-10 & Luke 6.38 (2) Matthew 25.34-40 & Romans 8.29 (3) 1 Corinthians 9.13-14 & 1 Timothy 5.17-18 (4) Galatians 6.10 & Luke 16.9 (5) Matthew 6.1-4 2 (5) 2 Corinthians 9.1-5 (6) 2 Corinthians 9.7 & 2 Corinthians 9.8-10 (7) 2 Corinthians 9.11-15 (8) 1 Timothy 5.8 <u>Friday</u>: The EARTH: Genesis 1.28, 2.15, Psalm 24.1, Proverbs 12.10, Matthew 10.29, Romans 1.20, Romans 8.19-20, 1 Corinthians 4.2, Colossians 1.16-17, Ezekiel 34.18-19. What do we learn about the creation, God and man's responsibility.

\_\_\_\_\_you give... Matthew 6.2

- In the old Testament Law Giving was a requirement that equaled 23.3% of everything.
  - 10% went to the \_\_\_\_\_\_ and running the government. (Deut. 14:22-27)
  - 10% went to the \_\_\_\_\_\_ for their religious service to the people. (Num. 18: 21, 24).
  - 10% every third year went to supporting the needs of \_\_\_\_\_\_ and the poor or crippled. (Deut. 14:28, 29)
