<u>Monday</u>: Read the following verses from Ephesians: Ep 1:22; Ep 3:10; Ep 3:21; Ep 5:22; Ep 5:23; Ep 5:24; Ep 5:25; Ep 5:27; Ep 5:29; Ep 5:32. What do we learn about the church from these verses?

<u>Tuesday</u>: What do we learn about the church from the following verses? (You can use your sermon notes to help with the answers.) Ephesians 1.22-23; 2.19-22; 3.14-15; 5.25-27;6.10-18. <u>Wednesday</u>: Read Ephesians 1.3-14. What has God done for us? What does He expects us to do in return? What is the key to making this happen?

<u>**Thursday</u>**: Read Ephesians 1.15-23 What request does Paul pray the believes have as part of their lives? How is each one important in a believers spiritual growth?</u>

<u>Friday</u>: Read Acts 19:1-41 Here is the birth of the church at Ephesus. Why were the believers in Jesus in conflict with the non-believers? What can we learn from them about such conflict and how the church must face opposition?

BONUS: Read Revelations 2.1-7 What was the assessment of the church in Ephesus given by Jesus to John? What were they doing right? Wrong? What changes did they need to make? What promises are made to the church?

NOTE: About 4,500 Protestant churches closed in 2019, the last year data is available, with about 3,000 new churches opening, according to Lifeway Research. It was the first time the number of churches in the U.S. hadn't grown since the evangelical firm started studying the topic.


