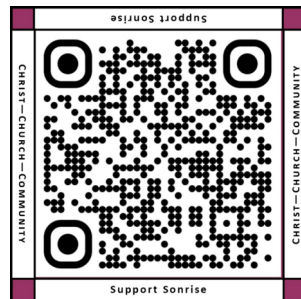

This week's challenge is to discover the real meaning...

MONDAY—Read Romans 8.31-39 What difficulties are listed as challenges that the believer may face as a follower of Christ? What promises are given to the believer to help them face these challenges?

TUESDAY—Read Philippians 4.10-14 What contrasts does Paul write about in his life? How does Paul approach these different challenges? What is the promise Paul claims in his life? How is this different from the way most people use this promise?

WEDNESDAY—Read Matthew 6.25-34 What type of things do people worry about? What promise is made here? What condition must be met for the promise to be in effect?

THURSDAY—Read Jeremiah 29.10-14 This is written to people in captivity who are being punished for their sinfulness. How long will they have to wait before these promises are given to them? What are they promised? How can you apply this to your life?

FRIDAY—Read Romans 8.28 What are the “all things” Paul is talking about? (HINT: read Romans 8.18-23) What is the purpose of “all things” working together? What is the promise here, and what is the key to it happening in the life of a believer?

BONUS - Read Mark 10.23-27 What did Jesus tell the disciples that confused them? What was the promise Jesus spoke about? How is this verse misquoted and misused?

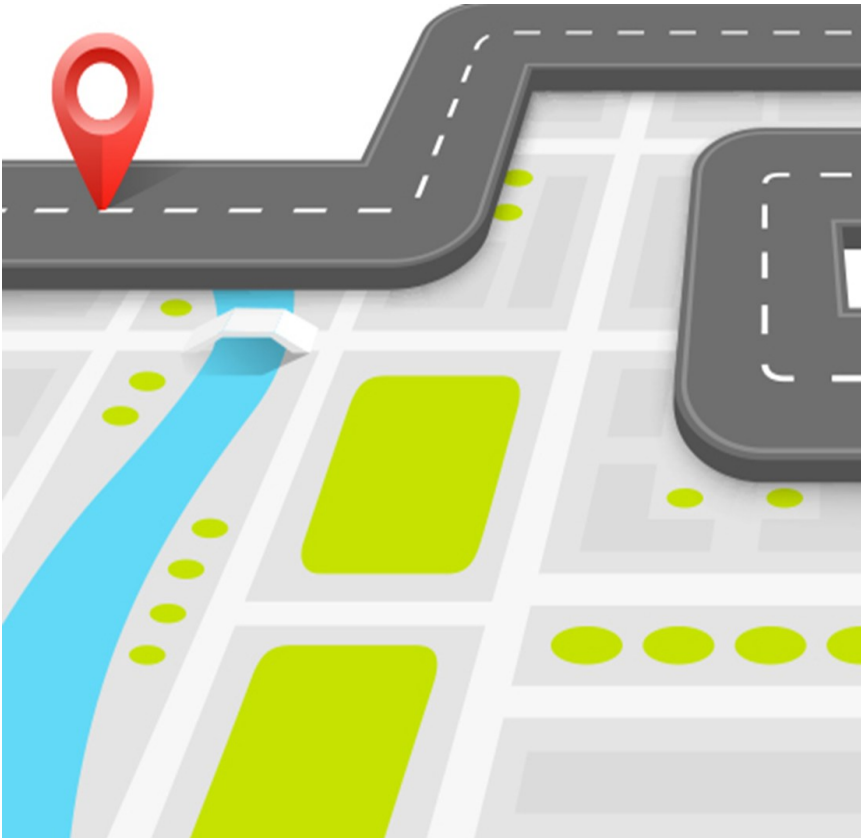
