

Look up and write out the following Scriptures. These will prepare you for this week's study. John 13.34, Matthew 22.39, Luke 10.27, 1 John 4.7.

MONDAY —Read The Parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37) What boundaries does love overcome in the story? What was the key problem the lawyer had with Jesus' teachings? **TUESDAY**—Read The Parable of the Prodigal Son (Luke 15:11-32) How is the father's love demonstrated in his releasing the son to his own design for life? What is the key to the son's wanting to be with the father? How does the father show his love for the son? What do we learn about God's love from this?

WEDNESDAY—Read The Parable of the Lost Sheep (Luke 15:1 -7) How is God's love different than man's love? What new truth do we learn about God and the lost sinner from this story?

THURSDAY—Read The Parable of the Unforgiving Servant (Matthew 18:21-35) How is love tied to forgiveness in a person's life? How is forgiveness tied to the love of God and our own salvation?

FRIDAY—Read The Parable of the Great Banquet (Luke 14:15-24) How does this story show God's love? How should we apply this lesson to our personal lives? To our local church? How does God respond to those who turn down his invitation?

BONUS - Read The Parable of the Good Shepherd (John 10:1-18) How does the shepherd demonstrate His love for the sheep? What is the relationship between the shepherd and the sheep? What is the key lesson Jesus wants you to learn from this story?

The QUESTION of LOVE!

There are two key types of LOVE in the New Testament;
 1. ______ Love: The deep committed Love as demonstrated by God through Jesus.
 ◇ John 3.16 Jesus on the cross dying for us.
 2. _____ Love: This is shallow human love based on feelings or position
 ◇ Matthew 6.5 "for they LOVE to pray... to be seen.."
 ◇ Matthew 26.48 'The one I KISS... arrest him."
