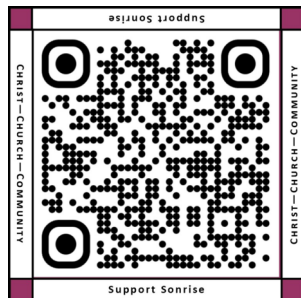

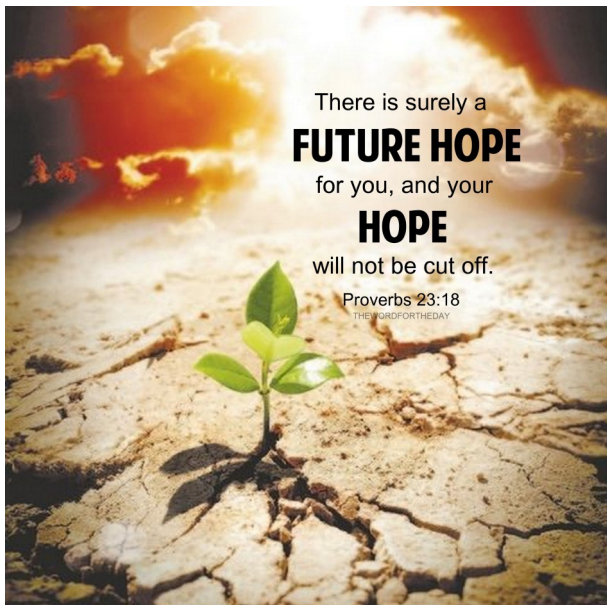
**Broken Hearts and Lost Dreams**  
**Luke 21.13-21a**

**MONDAY**—Read Hope for the Rejected - The Woman Weeping at Jesus' Feet (Luke 7:36–50)

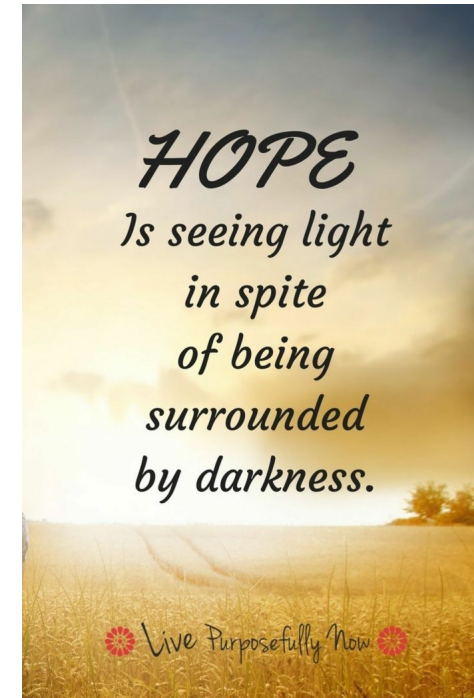
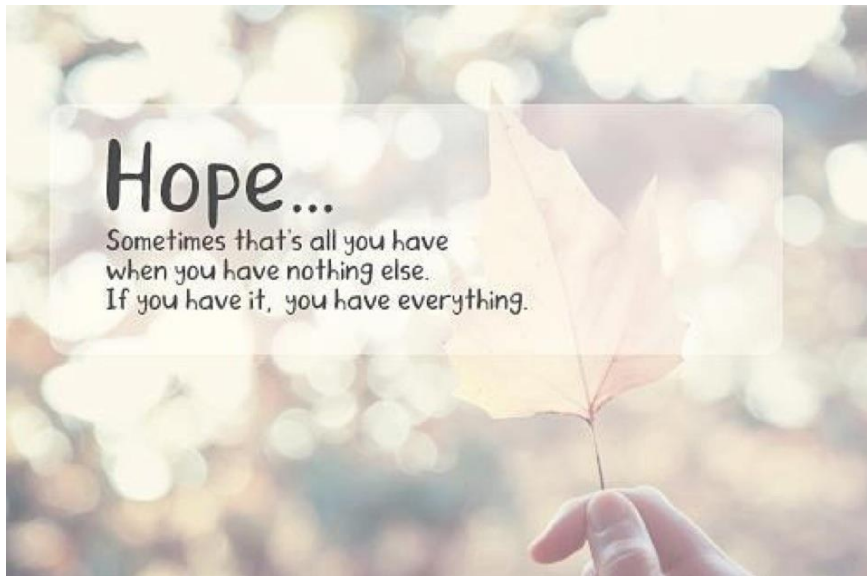
**TUESDAY**—Read Hope for the Non-Religious - Pharisee & Tax Collector (Luke 18:9–17)

**FRIDAY**—Read Hope changes life direction—Blind Bartimaeus ( Mark 10:46-52)

**BONUS** - Read Hope through death—Thieves on the Cross (Luke 23:26-43)
