

Early Church Leaders

- ◆ Simon, AKA _____. Famous for denying Jesus THREE times, briefly walking on water, getting scolded by God the Father, and preaching the message where 3,000+ were saved, and the church was born. **Goes from being a fisherman to a fisher of men.**
- ◆ Saul, AKA _____. A famous Pharisee who is known for persecuting the church, holding the coats of those who stoned Stephen to death. He is saved and, through his writings, develops the church's basic theological and structural foundations. **Goes from being a tent maker to the builder of the church.**
- ◆ John, son of Zebedee and Salome, AKA _____ the Beloved Disciple, who tried to get special treatment from Jesus in the Kingdom. He wrote five books of the New Testament, including John and Revelation. **Goes from mending nets to mending the church.**

What to watch for this week.

These are included to help get you started with your devotional each day.

1. **(Sun)** Watch for what happens inside the Jewish synagogues. What can we learn about where evil tries to hide out?
2. **(Mon)** Watch for key facts about the ministry of Jesus. How does his fulfillment of Old Testament prophecy strengthen his ministry?



- ◆ Mark 9.2-8

Six days later, Jesus took Peter, James, and John, and led them up a high mountain to be alone. As the men watched, Jesus' appearance was transformed, and his clothes became dazzling white, far whiter than any earthly bleach could ever make them. Then Elijah and Moses appeared and began talking with Jesus. Peter exclaimed, "Rabbi, it's wonderful for us to be here! Let's make three shelters as memorials—one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." He said this because he didn't really know what else to say, for they were all terrified.

Then a cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my dearly loved Son. _____ TO _____. " Suddenly, when they looked around, Moses and Elijah were gone, and they saw only Jesus with them.

- ◆ This is a pivotal point in the life of Jesus as He _____ for the key event in His life, which includes the trial, torture, crucifixion, and death on the cross.
- ◆ He is transformed and has a meeting with Elijah and Moses.

- ◆ Peter recommends _____ for them. One for Moses (the Law), one for Elijah (the Prophets), and one for the Son (Jesus), as if they are of **EQUAL IMPORTANCE**.
- ◆ God stops Peter and declares, "This is my dearly loved Son. _____ TO _____. "
- ◆ The Law represented by Moses is about to be done away with and replaced with Mercy and Grace of the new covenant or contract.
- ◆ The Prophets will no longer stand between man and God. Now, anyone can ask of God and expect to be heard and to hear an answer.
- ◆ Suddenly, when they looked around, Moses and Elijah were gone, and **THEY SAW** _____ with them.
- ◆ Here is the great truth of the New Covenant. It is about Jesus, and Jesus alone. The Law only remains for those who do not know Jesus as their savior and Lord. (see Romans 3.20)
