

MONDAY—Read Ephesians 1.20-21 & Ephesians 2.4-7 What position does Christ occupy now? How is this important to our understanding of our relationship to Him, Paul talked about in Ephesians 2.6? How does this benefit our prayer life? Daily life? When faced with difficult times?

TUESDAY—Read 2 Timothy 3.16-17 How does the word of God help the believer? What are the four key purposes of the word of God? (explain each one) What is the goal or end result of making the word of God a part of the believer's life?

WEDNESDAY—Read Galatians 5.16 24 Contrast the gifts of the Spirit with the flesh. What is the key to a successful Christian life? How is this (WALK) a key to helping others understand Christ's mission?

THURSDAY—Read Mark 10.17-27 How did the young man think he was going to get to heaven? The three areas of temptation are pleasure, possessions, and power, which one was stopping him from eternal life? In verse 27, what is the key to anyone's salvation?

FRIDAY—Read Matthew 11.28-30 Who is Jesus calling? What does he want them to do? How does this apply to your life? How can we know that this has happened in your life?

BONUS - Read Psalm 1. What part of this stands out or speaks to you the most? Why? How can you apply this to your life?
