



- He wanted them to know the , of GOD. (5.12) The POWER of God in their daily lives defeating the enemy and filling them.
- He wanted them to "\_\_\_\_\_ " ESV or "STAND FAST" NIV (5.12) He wanted them to be **unmovable** and **unvielding** in their faith.



## THE CHOSEN

- She who is in Babylon, together *with you*, (5.13)
- Understanding how we become the

- HE \_\_\_\_\_ or picked us to be followers of Jesus.
- \_\_\_\_\_ us. This comes from two Greek ٠ words which mean, Before, and appointed or determined. Hence predetermined for foreordained.
- Taken by itself, this sounds like God is deciding who is saved and who is lost. That is not what He is saying.
- Ephesians 1.11 says, "In him we were also \_\_\_\_\_, having been \_\_\_\_\_ according to the plan of him who works out everything in conformity with the purpose of his will..."
- Again, this scripture makes it sound like God decided who is going to be saved and who is not.
- The key here is using the four rules to interpret scripture. We will use the first two to help us properly understand what this means.
