

<u>Monday</u>: Read John 9.39 and John 3.17 How can the two statements both be true?

<u>Tuesday</u>: Read John 9.1-3 & Jeremiah 31.29-30 What do we learn about sin and consequences from these two sets of verses? Besides eternal consequences how can sin effect a person's life?

<u>Wednesday</u>: Read Psalms 119.11 & Romans 3.20b & Romans 6.14 Define what they mean by the word "LAW." What is the purpose of the Law? What purpose does the law serve for a believer? Is a believer bound by the LAW? (Explain your answer.)

<u>Thursday</u>: The Pharisees were hung up on the LAW and the SABBATH. Read Ezekiel 20.12 & Colossians 2.16-17 & Romans 14.5 How should Christian Believers approach the subject of the Sabbath?

<u>Friday</u>: Read John 9.35-38 & Daniel 7.13-14 What can we know for sure about the title 'Son of Man?'

<u>BONUS</u>: Read Galatians 5.19-25: Contrast the DEEDS of THE FLESH with the FRUIT of THE SPIRIT. How do they each show us the conflict between PHYSICAL and SPIRITUAL? What is the key to victory? (Explain)
