<u>Wednesday</u>: Read Psalm 42.1-2 & Proverbs 24.1-2 What does God want me to desire?

<u>**Thursday</u>**: Read Romans 12.9-17 What Does God want me to do?</u>

<u>Friday</u>: Read Revelations 4.8, Psalm 23.1-6, Matthew 28.18 -20 What do I learn about God?

BONUS: Read 1 Peter 1.3-5, 1 John 1.5-10, 1 Peter 2.4-12 What do I learn about relating to God?

Week of May 13-18 Digging Deeper

What does it mean to be a disciple or follower of Jesus. Jesus set some pretty high standards. Study the following and <u>don't</u> <u>get discouraged</u> if it seems really hard. The closer you get to Jesus the easier it gets. Remember you can look at the scriptures before and after the ones in this week's lesson to help you understand.

<u>**Thursday</u>**: Read Mark 12.30 How can you love the Lord in the different ways listed in this verse? You may need to let this one marinate in your mind for awhile.</u>

Friday: Read John 15.18-27 Jesus was always honest with His disciples. What do we learn about being a follower of Jesus here? Why would Jesus want us to know this? How can knowing this help us in our daily lives as Easter People in a Good Friday world?

BONUS: John 15.12-17 What does it take to be a disciple of Jesus? What is the ultimate goal of a servant or follower of Jesus? How is this goal reached and what is the promise of Jesus to all who discover this secret?
