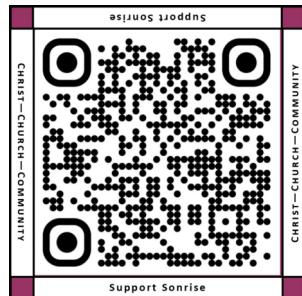

- ◆ Pentecost is celebrated _____ after Passover.

These are included to help get you started
with your devotional each day.

7. **(Sat)** Watch for the statements Jesus makes about himself. Why is Jesus so important in your relationship with God the Father?

Up to that time the Spirit had not been given, since Jesus had not yet been glorified. John 7.37-39
